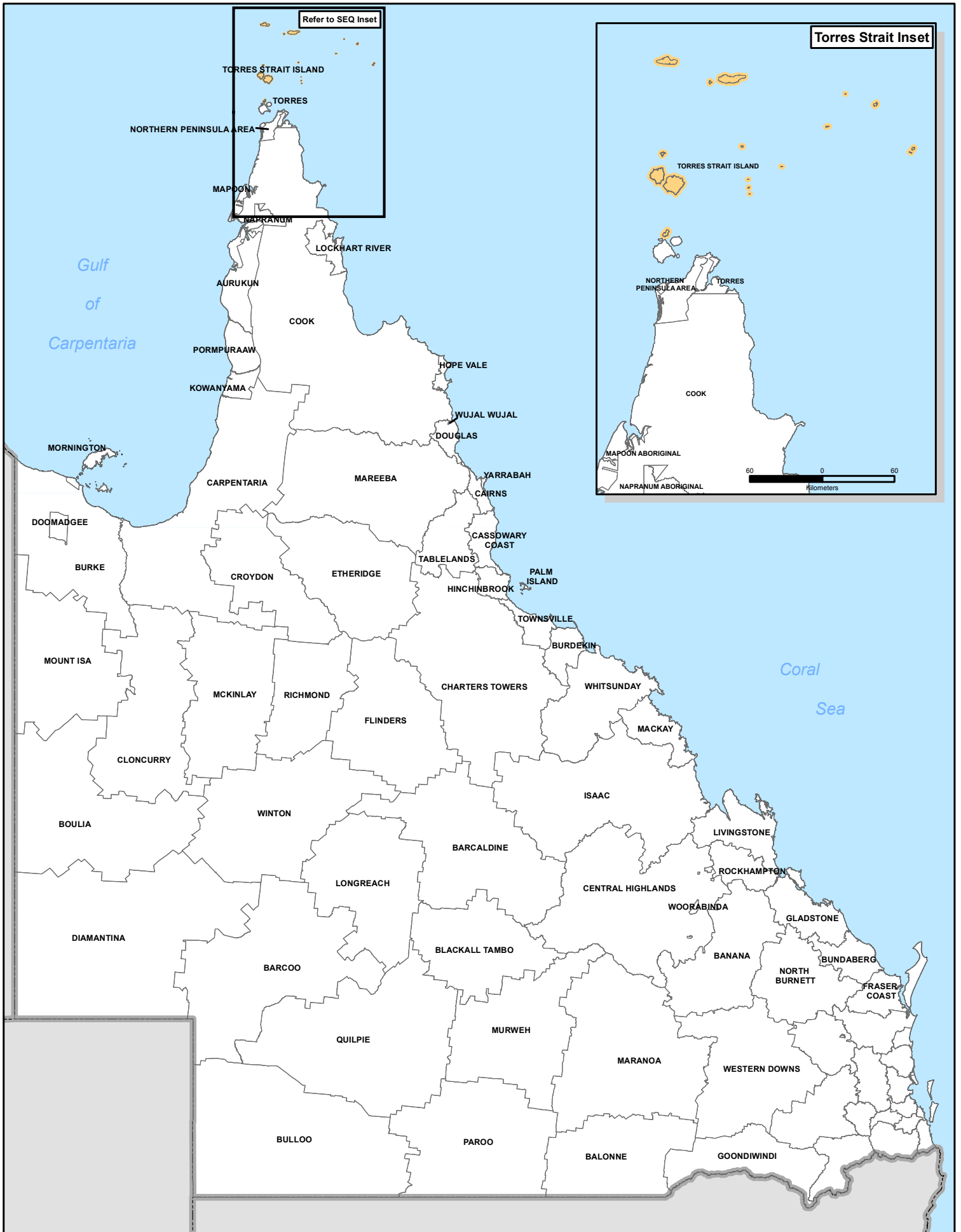
NDRRA Relief Measures Activated –
